



GECINA LEASES "LE BUILDING" TO BANQUE DE FRANCE



GECINA has signed a lease with Banque de France for the "Le Building" office property located at 37 rue du Louvre, in Paris' second arrondissement.

This lease concerns the building's entire office space, with 7,223 sq.m spread over eight floors.

On this transaction, GECINA was advised by Catella, and Banque de France by Jones Lang LaSalle.

This emblematic building, the historical headquarters of the French newspaper Le Figaro, was acquired by GECINA in 2005 and has been fully redeveloped, with work to be completed in December this year.

Thanks to the know-how of GECINA, the investor and principal for this operation, and the work of François Roux, the architecture agency ateliers 234, and Robert Dal Sasso, for the interior design, the elegant architecture of the 30s has in this way found a new modernity, while preserving the memory of the place.
